INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION

You must answer all the questions on the application form and you may attach additional sheets or a resume as necessary. Please make sure that you sign the signature line and that you obtain the signature of a parent or guardian if you are not yet 18 at the time of this application. Assemble all the sheets and mail in a normal non-expensive envelope. Do not send anything that requires a signature. No one is home during the day to sign for the item and the post office is closed when I return from work so obtaining your packet from the post office is very difficult and will have to wait for a Saturday morning.

If you are currently in college, you will need to send us your college grades, otherwise, we are looking to obtain your high school transcript. This Percheron Horse Association Education and Charitable Fund Scholarship is worth a maximum of one thousand dollars in a one-year time period. The first half of the scholarship will be paid by August as soon as you have provided your college information. In December you will need to send a transcript of your fall grades. The following requirements must be met in order to keep this scholarship:

1. You must provide us with a local newspaper address for a news release. Hopefully your high school will also publish your award at graduation.
2. The first semester of college you must obtain a 2.5 gpa.

The scholarship money will be sent directly to your college/university's financial office. You will need to provide the committee with your institution's financial aid office address and your account number. Please make sure that your grades are sent in a timely fashion in December so we can send your scholarship money for the next semester. In the early spring, you might like to obtain one recommendation for this scholarship to reapply for your second year of college. We will keep your original application and add the recommendation to it. You can reapply for a total of four years or four thousand dollars. In some instances, we may award a smaller one-time amount.
